→Want to know more about Asia

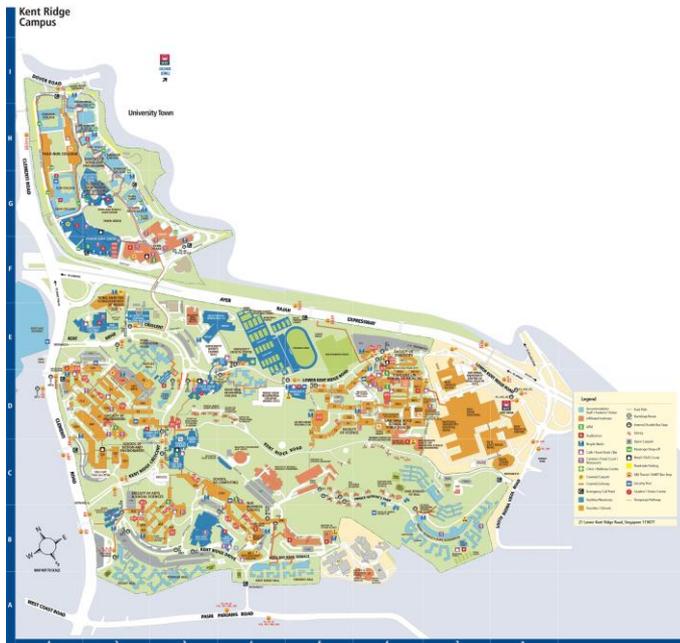


- Why Singapore? Because I can look at Asia with a wide view.
