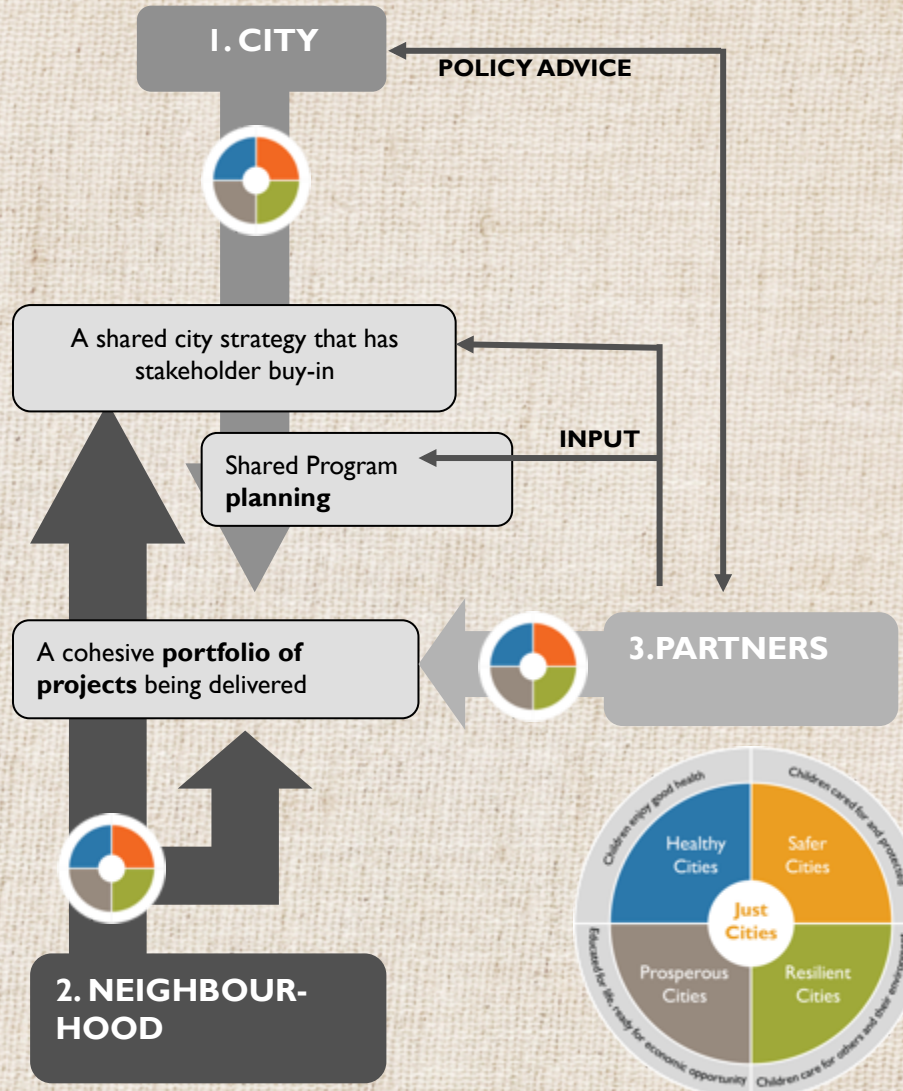

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WVI ROLES IN URBAN DEVELOPMENT

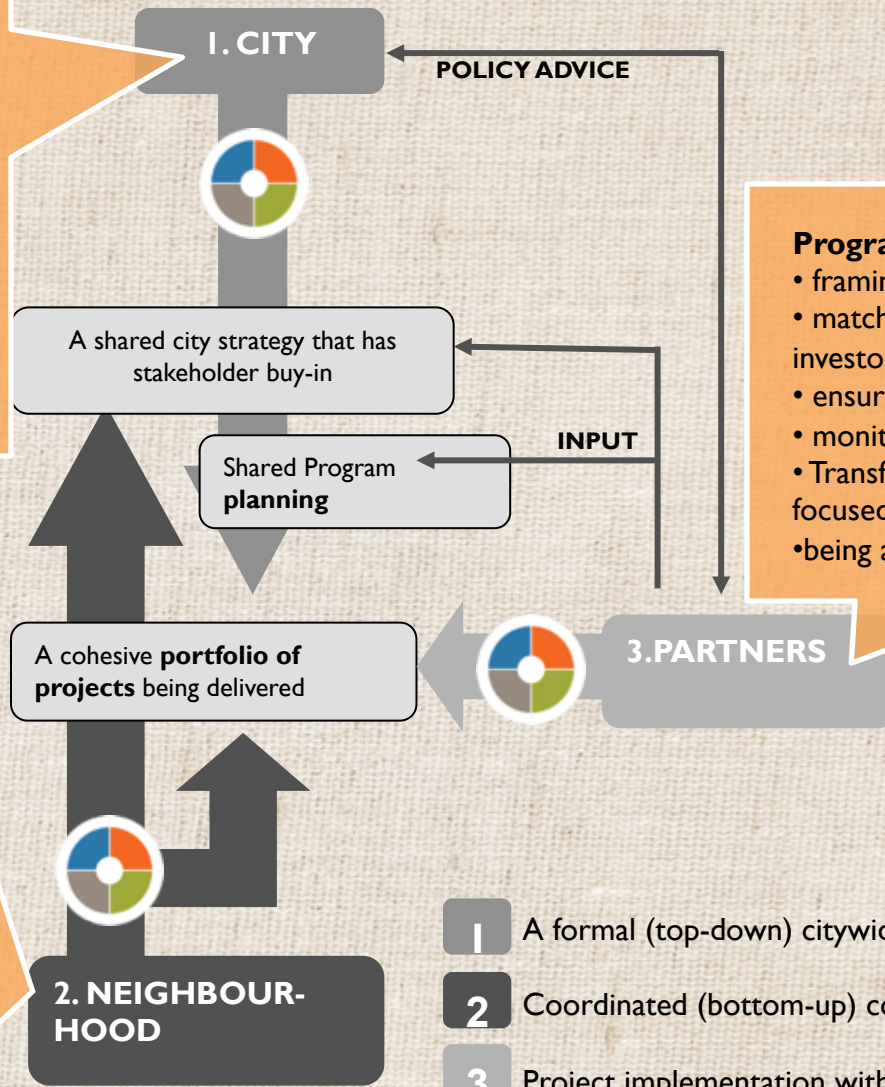


STRATEGIC FACILITATOR

- Transformation of community to ensure children wellbeing

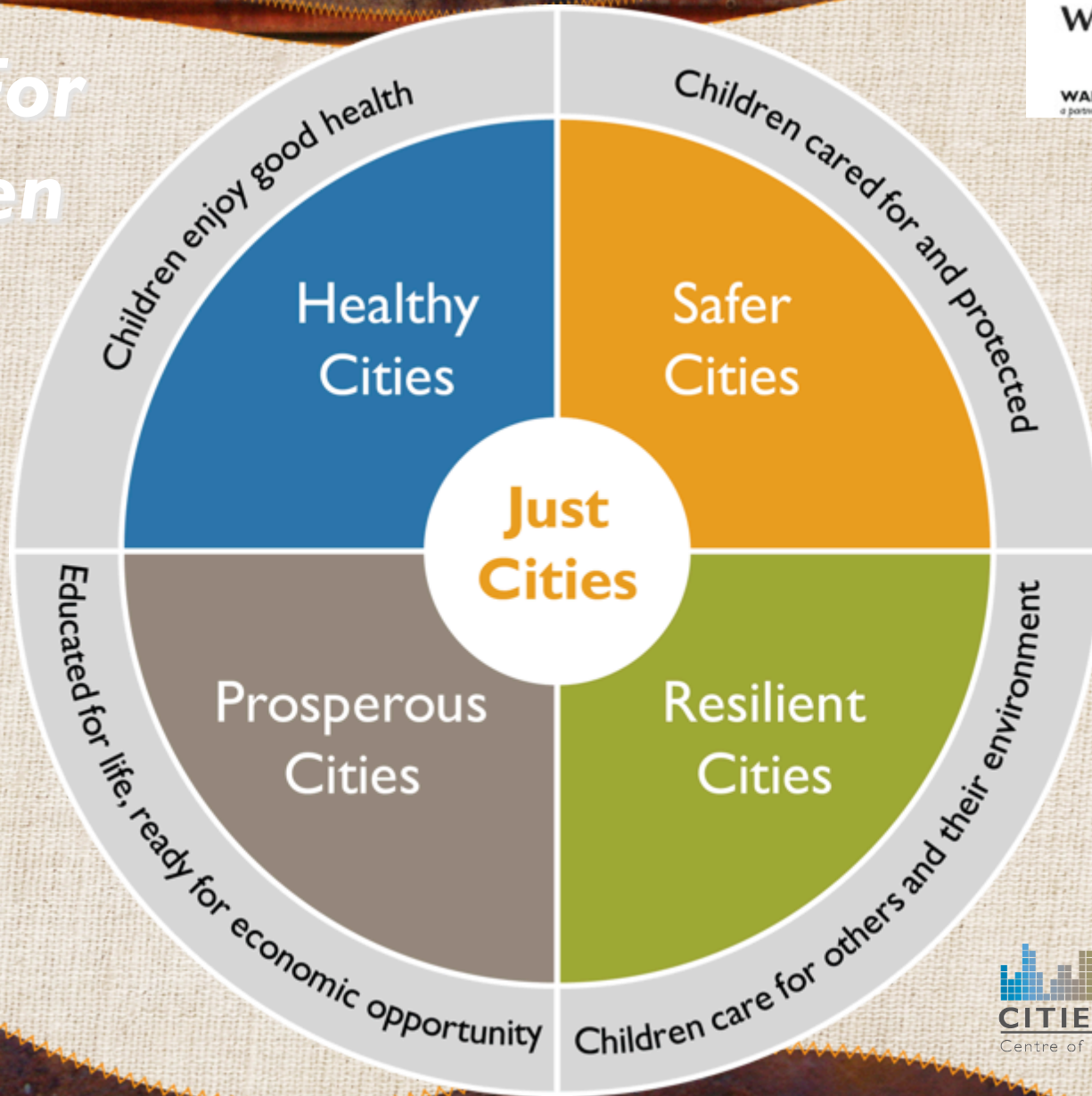


Program broker/monitor

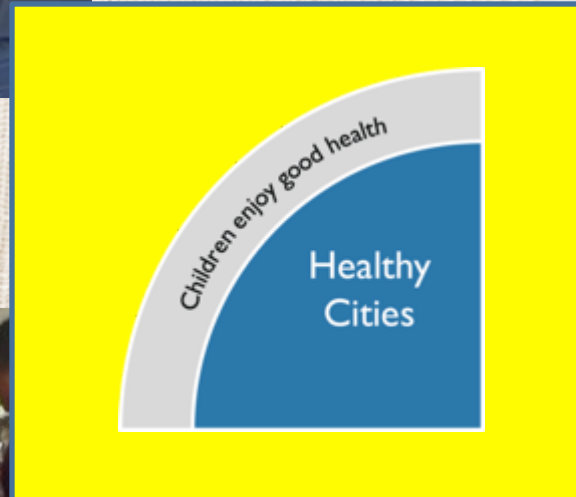

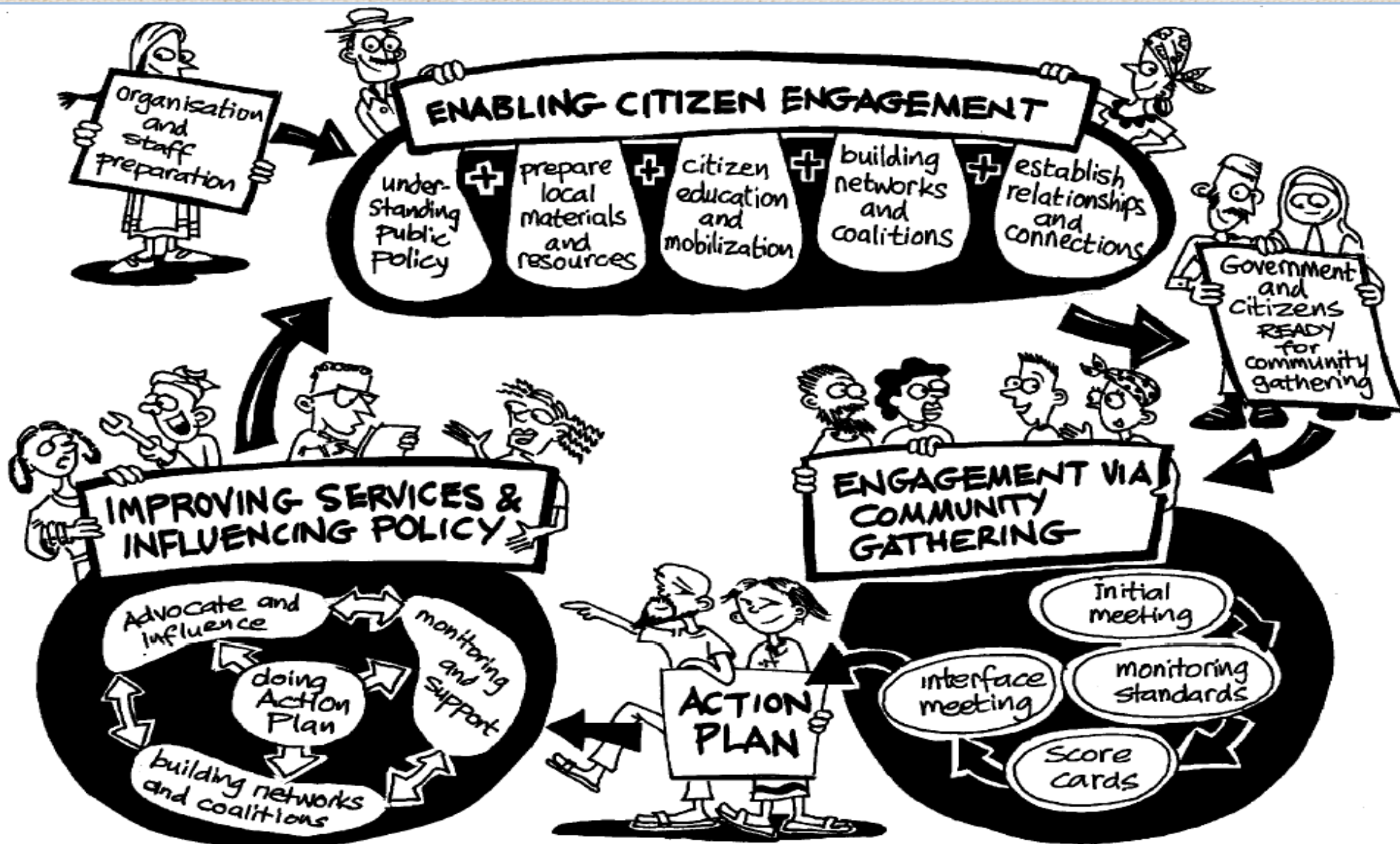
